



**You Can't Afford To Share ShopKey Software  
With Multiple Shop Locations!**

**Sharing login information can result in fines or damages up to,  
or exceeding, \$150,000!**

Purchasing a Single User license (five users within a single shop location) and sharing your login username and password allowing multiple shop locations access to the same account is strictly prohibited and in violation of the terms and conditions of the ShopKey End User License Agreement (EULA).

Should your shop make available any portion of the ShopKey software product, you shall be liable for the payment to ShopKey of the equivalent cost of the additional user fees. ShopKey may require that your shop locations immediately and entirely remove any implementation of the software product that is in breach of the EULA. In addition, your shop shall be liable for the payment to ShopKey of court costs, attorney's fees, punitive damages, and any other legal remedy appropriate for the situation. Unintentional license violations can be subject to the same kinds of penalties as intentional violations and can end up being very expensive.

ShopKey reserves the right to terminate (without any refund) at any point if ShopKey determines that users are not in compliance with the EULA. Such terminations take effect immediately and will not issue any refunds. If ShopKey determines that users violated the EULA, ShopKey also reserves the right to terminate all current and future access, including access to any collected data.
